The app – Ireland: Myths and Legend – was developed in close collaboration with Jim Fitzpatrick, a celebrated Irish artist. It enables the user to explore and expand the finest details of his intricate Celtic artwork using the ‘pinch and stretch’ function of the iPad.

EyeSpyFX, established by University of Ulster academic Anthony Hutton, initially emerged from research into the remote control of robotic devices via the web, and subsequently evolved into specialist app development.
